HELPED THOUSANDS OF FAMILIES GET THE CARE THEY NEED

CHOC treats over 220,000 children annually, regardless of their ability to pay. CHOC supporters help ease the burden of hospital bills for families, allowing them to focus on their child. In 2018, CHOC provided over \$52 million in uncompensated care to meet every family's needs.



TRAVELED OVER 100,000 MILES

In 2018, the emergency department team brought nearly 4,200 patients to our hospital so they could receive immediate, life-saving care. We also launched CHOC1, our own emergency helicopter, which helps us reach patients at even greater distances and provide better access to care. CHOC1 now flies all over the Southland, from south Orange County to the Inland Empire—even as far north as Bakersfield—transporting critically ill patients back to CHOC.



SUPPORTED BOTH PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL HEALTH

Over the past two years, our child life team hired seven new specialists and teachers to extend their reach throughout the hospital. With these additional staff members, we were able to expand music therapy into every hospital unit, provide comfort and education to more than 11,000 families in the emergency department and offer unique child life services in the mental health inpatient center.



YOU HELP CHANGE LIVES

As a non-profit hospital, CHOC relies on community support to go above and beyond for patients like Logan.

Logan was diagnosed with a degenerative neurological disease that rendered him immobile. Initially, he relied on a shopping cart pushed by a family member for transportation. With community funding, CHOC was able to purchase a mobility chair. Now, Logan can attend school, play with other children and participate in everyday activities. Because of generosity like yours, his childhood was restored.
