TREATED THOUSANDS OF FAMILIES

In 2018, the orthopaedic outpatient clinic received 14,750 patient visits, a 10 percent increase over last year. We are proud to treat a wide variety of conditions, from broken bones to spinal problems, to help every child grow up strong and healthy.

The rehabilitation services department is relocating to a new, more accessible location in late 2019 that will enable its expansion.
