

Frequently Asked Questions: Medical/Surgical Unit at CHOC Children's at Mission Hospital

When will I see my child's doctor?

You will be visited daily by a hospitalist, a pediatrician who practices in the hospital.

How will I have my questions answered?

Please ask any team member if you have a question. It is important to us that we hear your concerns and answer all your questions. We also encourage you to take notes to jot down questions as they arise or to record answers. You're also encouraged to use the whiteboard in your child's room to write down your questions.

When do visiting hours end?

Visiting hours end at 8 p.m. Parents can come and go at any hour, and a parent can stay the night at the bedside. A cot or sleeping chair will be provided.

Will my child have a private room?

We cannot guarantee a private room for any patient. For patients in double rooms, we are careful to make the most appropriate pairings of patients. Curtains between the beds help establish privacy.

Do I have to pay for parking?

We offer parking validation for parents.
